

**Midex/NeuroSchool mobility grants to neuroscience master's students from your university interested in coming to train in Marseille (South of France)**

Mobility can include laboratory training (max. 6 months) but also courses.

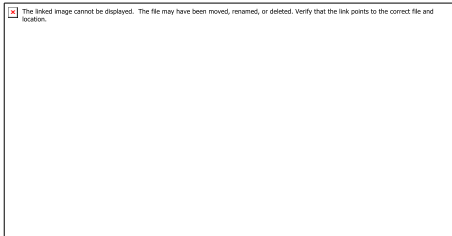

Since 2015, we have hosted dozens of master's students from our partner universities and the feedback has been extremely positive, both from the students and their supervisors.

Please note that for stays starting between April and August 2023, **applicants must submit their applications by Sunday, December 4th, 2022.** The following call will have a deadline of May 1st, 2023 for stays in Marseille beginning between September 2023 and March 2024.

To increase their chances of coming to Marseille, interested students are invited to look for other funding as well, for instance through the Erasmus office at your university.
